Q1. How useful Information has been organized in this site?

Database on Indian Economy (hereafter DBIE) has mainly six parts - Home, Statistics, Time-series Publications, Unit Level Data, Economy Watch and Whats New.

Home page: It helps user to navigate different links, reports and charts related to RBI's Data Warehouse. Many options are available in the header of the home page to navigate feedback page, contact us, disclaimer, publication etc. The dashboards are also present in the home page for the user to see the trends of few macro-economic data. Home page also contains an interactive report named 'Branch Locator' which is very useful to find out scheduled bank's location & other related information. Users have the facility to provide feedbacks using the Feedback option available on homepage. Contact details are also available in the footer of the website under the 'Contact us' for further interaction. Home page also contains information about the following areas under the head 'Useful Links': DBIE Brochure, Downloading Data into Excel, DBIE Data Release Calendar, Link for RBI Main website, Best View Information and Guide for Monthly RBI Bulletin.

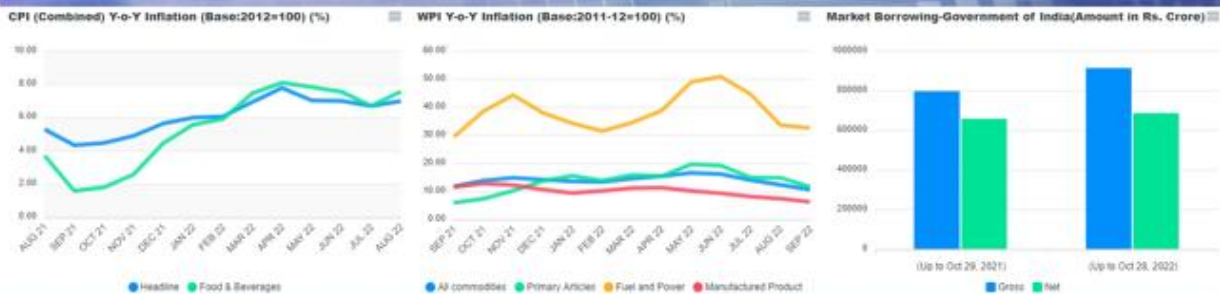

Statistics Page: The entire statistics have been presented in seven subject areas. They are Real Sector, Corporate Sector, Financial Sector, Financial Market, External Sector, Public Finance, SocioEconomic Indicators. Sectors have different sub-sectors and reports under the sub-sectors have been organized on periodicity wise.

Time-Series Publications: Under Time-series Publications, various tables available under the Banks publications are organized under the respective publication tabs. Time-series Publications differ from the print-versions of the publication in terms of the report formats. Reports under Time-series Publications are continuously updated without waiting for the annual print versions, and the report formats are time-series friendly and has historical data.

Unit Level Data: The IESH and CSS Survey data is available under this page.

Economy Watch: Through this page, the use can navigate to different kind of charts related to macro-economic data. The Subject area available in the left panel can be navigated for selecting the different kind of charts.

Whats New: Recently released data information is being provided here.

Q2. What are the supporting browsers & preferable Resolution for this website?
